Tinfoil Boat Experiment

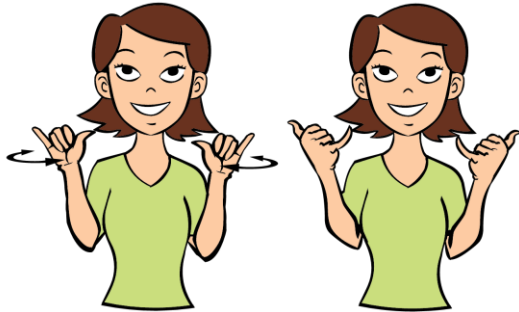

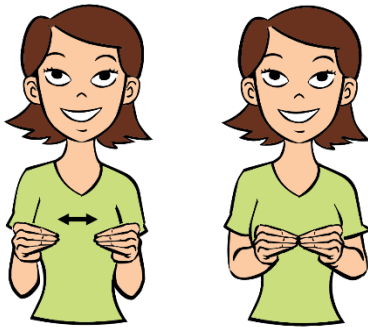
