Adult – Home Share

Home Share is a unique living option for a person who has a developmental disability, where they share a home with someone who provides ongoing support. Support may include assistance in daily living skills, training to develop their independence, self-care, relationship building, life skills, along with access and use of community resources and activities.

Referrals to receive Home Share services are made through CLBC. Home Share providers will be matched with the specific needs, interests and lifestyle preferences of the person receiving the support. There will be many considerations involved in selecting an appropriate Home Share contractor for each person, while we seek to find the best matches for everyone!

Home Share Contractors are independent contractors who agree to share their home with an adult with a disability.

Not only do they offer a place to live, they also focus on developing close relationships and providing opportunities for the individual to be active in the community through work, recreation and the pursuit of personal interests.

All Home Share provider's undergo a rigorous screening process including an in-depth home study which asks questions about the family dynamics, lifestyle, person support network and conflict management just to mention a few.

MACL's Home Share Contractors understand that this is a lifestyle choice, not a job. There is no eight hour shift and then a return to their families and homes; each member of the family must be open to the changes that Home Share brings.

Our contractors provide safe homes that meet all applicable safety standards.

In order to become a qualified MACL Home Share Contractor applicants must complete an interview and assessment process consisting of:

- An extensive screening process
- A detailed written application
- Self assessment
- Home study process
- Physicians clearance
- Criminal Record Search
- Completion of personal & professional references
- Home safety check
